**SUBJECT:** COVID-19

**LOCAL RISK FACTOR:** Medium High

**POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE:** Today the Saint Paul Island Unified Command was informed that four essential workers tested positive for COVID-19 on Tuesday, January 11, 2022. The individuals will isolate until they complete a 10-day isolation. These cases are in addition to the one case reported earlier today.

**ACTIONS TO TAKE** to ensure the safety of the community:

- The positive individuals will isolate for 10 days.

**TOTAL POSITIVE CASES TO DATE:** Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic Saint Paul Island has had or has 21 individuals that have tested positive for COVID-19.

**ACTIVE POSITIVE CASES:** As of today, Saint Paul Island has 12 active COVID-19 cases.

**GET TESTED IF YOU ARE SICK:** If are feeling ill or sick no matter how minor the symptoms get tested for COVID-19. Contact the Saint Paul Health Center during normal business hours to arrange to get tested. Additionally, if you are feeling sick stay home from school or work.

**GET VACCINATED AND BOOSTED:** To protect yourself and others against COVID-19 if eligible get vaccinated and boosted.
