

SAFEGUARD YOUR FREEZERS



Tips to help protect your food-storage freezers before the next storm.

- Elevate freezers above flood levels. Elevating even a few inches can reduce flood risk significantly. Components should be elevated as high as practical to achieve the greatest benefit.
- Relocate electrical wiring, junction boxes, switches and outlets above the expected flood levels to protect from flood damage.
- Relocate freezers to structures on higher ground if elevating is not possible.
