Field Games

Game	Age(s)	Info
1. Daddy and Me Race	1&2	Over, hand-in-hand, to the finish line.
2. Stop and Stoop	1&2, 3&4	Over
3. Mommy and Me Race	3&4	Over and Back hand-in-hand.
4. Ring Drop	3, 4	Run one ring at a time and drop on the cone. Winner is first back to the start after both rings are dropped.
5. Bean Bag Balance	5&6	Run to the finish balancing a bean bag on your head
6. Wooden Egg on a Spoon Race	5&6	Race to the finish while balancing an egg on a spoon
7. Speed Race	5&6	Over and back as fast as you can!
8. Three-Legged Race	7 to 9, 10 to 12	
9. Over and Under Relay	7 to 9, 10 to 12 (Quintet)	In line, person in from hands item over their head to next person who then hands it under their legs to the next person.
10. Head, Shoulders, Knees, Cup	7 to 9, 10 to 12 (Pair)	Pairs stand facing each other with a cup on the ground between them. When cup is said first to grab wins and finds a new partner among the winners until there is only one.
11. Cup Pass Relay	13 thru 17 (Quintet)	With straw in mouth, hold cup on the end and pass to the next person in line. First group to pass it down and back wins.
12. Head, Shoulders, Knees, Cup	13 thru 17 (Pair)	
13. Distance Launch	13 thru 17 (Triad)	
14. Couple's Minute Life Saver Pass	18+	Toothpick in mouth, couples' pickup, pass and drop into a cup. Most passed in 3 minutes wins.
15. Distance Throw-Women	18+	Winner is the one who throws their weighted ball the farthest.
16. Distance Throw-Men	18+	Make sure to run and grab your ball after.
17. Distance Launch-Women	18+ (Triad)	Winner is the one who launches their egg the farthest.
18. Distance Launch-Men	18+ (Triad)	
19. Boardwalk-Women	18+	Over and Back
20. Boardwalk-Men	18+	
21. Extreme Egg Toss-Women	18+	Let's just say the eggs were ordered early. Partner on the starting line tosses, other partner catches, steps back, tosses.
22. Extreme Egg Toss-Men	18+	
23. Mini Pie Eating Contest-Women	18+	Winner is the one that finishes EATING their pie the fastest.
24. Mini Pie Eating Contest-Men	18+	
25. Grass Pile Coin Search	5-8, 9-12	2 piles
26. Grease Pole	18+ Registered	Be the first to capture the flag and hang from the top.
